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solitude is the state of being alone or isolated from others it is often a voluntary choice for meditation introspection reflection or simply enjoying one s own company solitude can be peaceful and conducive to deep thinking or creativity contrasting with loneliness which implies a negative feeling of being alone and disconnected this book investigates the types of solitude in twelve modern short stories written by authors of different nationalities races and genders it also explores how the setting boosts the state of solitude of each character there are different manifestations of solitude and the solitary character a person living among other people refusing to be part of them unwilling to be part of them or being refused and rejected to be part of them this character is a child a teenager a man or an abnormal freakish man or a woman of sorrow a recipient of much unbearable pain

this is the fourth volume sponsored by the united states board on books for young people following children s books from other countries 1998 the world through children s books 2002 and crossing boundaries 2006 this latest volume edited by linda m pavonetti includes books published between 2005 and 2009 this annotated bibliography organized geographically by world region and country with descriptions of nearly 700

books representing more than 70 countries is a valuable resource for librarians teachers and anyone else seeking to promote international understanding through children s literature like its predecessors it will be an important tool for providing stories that will help children understand our differences while simultaneously demonstrating our common humanity

written by some of today s most exciting teen authors vacations from hell offers five unique takes on a universal experience unforgettable trips this third hell collection features stories of vacations that take a serious turn for the worse when paranormal elements interfere claudia gray s teen witch falls for the wrong guy on her family s yearly beach trip cassandra clare s heroine confronts a vengeful and powerful woman while taking in the jamaican sun the cruise ship in sarah mlynowski s story carries some dead soon to be dead and even some un dead passengers aboard libba bray takes us to a town in eastern europe with a dark and bloody past and a paranoid madness born in the french revolution reaches across time to turn sister against sister in maureen johnson s tale

discussions of gender and sexuality have become part of mainstream conversations and are being reflected in the work of more and more writers of fiction particularly in literature aimed at young adult audiences but young readers regardless of their sexual orientation don t always know what books offer well rounded portrayals of queer characters and situations fortunately finding positive role models in fiction that features lgbtq themes has become less problematic though not without its challenges in representing the rainbow in young adult literature lgbtq content since 1969 christine jenkins and michael cart provide an overview of the literary landscape an expanded version of the heart has its reasons this volume charts the evolution of ya literature that features characters and themes which resonate not only with lgbtq readers but with their allies as well in this resource jenkins and cart identify titles that are notable either for their excellence accurate thoughtful and tactful depictions or deficiencies books that are wrongheaded stereotypical or outdated each chapter has been significantly updated and this edition also includes new chapters on bisexual transgender and intersex issues and characters as well as chapters on comics graphic novels and works of nonfiction this book also features an annotated bibliography and a number of author title lists of books discussed in the text that will aid teachers librarians parents and teen readers encompassing a wider array of sexual identities representing the rainbow in young adult literature is an invaluable resource for young people eager to read about books relevant to them and their lives

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
